Prayer

For today's time of prayer, we are going to be using the five finger prayer. When you put your hands together in prayer your thumb is closest so we start by praying for those closest to you – the ones you love. Next the pointer finger, prayer for those who point us in the right direction (parents, teachers). Our tallest finger is for our leaders (government, church leaders). Our ring finger is our weakest finger, we pray for the sick and those who need help. Our last finger the pinkie is to pray for ourselves.

- \Rightarrow Wild and tame animals to walk on the land.

But there was something missing. Do you know what is missing from God's creation?

It was people! God knew that he wanted to create people to take care of his beautiful plants and animals. God created Adam and he played with all the animals and fish. But Adam was lonely there were no other people. God knew what to do, he made a friend for Adam and named her Eve.

God looked at his big and beautiful world and do you know what he said? God said "IT IS GOOD."

The next day, the seventh day God had finished his work, and so he rested. God blessed the seventh day and made it special because on that day he rested from his work.

Popsicle Sticks Days of Creation
